ISSP recognizes that development and learning are interrelated. Our children develop knowledge, skills, concepts, attitudes which are relevant, engaging and challenging across subject areas. It is also an expectation that action will be a result of the learning process.

At ISSP we follow the IB PYP framework which consists of four units of inquiry that include key concepts, related concepts, lines of inquiry and transdisciplinary themes. We map the IB, American and Vietnamese standards to these units.

What distinguishes us is our community culture, personalized learning, and professional approaches, providing a rich and balanced international standard education.

REGGIO INSPIRED EARLY YEARS EDUCATION

Our teaching team at ISSP desires the best outcomes for our children. We consider many factors, exploring powerful and meaningful approaches to teaching and learning.

The image of the child underpins the heart of our play-based approach, which is inspired by the principles of the Reggio Emilia philosophy and the International Baccalaureate - Primary Years Program.

We are influenced by childhood developmental milestones to successfully achieve learning outcomes. Our children's voices are heard and respected which guides us in creating authentic experiences and meaningful learning environments.

RESTORATIVE PRACTICE AND STUDENT SUPPORT

How we work with children and the relationships we establish can be the difference between success and failure, and how they see themselves as learners. ISSP applies Restorative Practices which focuses on building relationships, creating obligations and opportunities for making things right. This builds character by supporting children in learning to make good decisions and having ownership of their decisions. Our approach develops long term change in a child's character.

Our Student Support team consists of a School Counselor, a team of English as an Additional Language Specialist and Special Educational Needs Specialist. As a staff, our collective aim is to ensure all children develop to their full potential through inclusive support, collaboration, commitment and communication.

It is ISSP's belief that all children have the right to receive a quality education by capitalizing on individual strengths. We recognize and respect individual differences and uniqueness and take responsibility in providing skilled and sensitive teaching and support so that children with different learning styles, abilities and skills can find individual paths to success and fulfillment.





COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

ISSP is a small and close-knit community, a great place to work, and a positive learning environment with supportive staff and a great leadership team. We offer a competitive salary and compensation package for successful candidates with the following notes:

We offer two types of contracts:

- 2 year contracts for overseas hired expatriates
- 2 year contracts for locally hired expatriates

Starting salary point: approximately 40,000 USD gross per year.

Overseas Hired Expatriates Package includes: housing allowance, flight benefits, shipping benefits, international health insurance, sick leave, personal leave, tuition waiver for up to 2 (two) children, professional development opportunities and a relocation/settling-in allowance.

Locally Hired Expatriates Package includes: international health insurance, sick leave, personal leave, professional development opportunities. The annual home flight benefit is offered once signing a second contract. It is possible that the school could honor the benefits from your former local school within the budget.
