A WARM WELCOME FROM ISSP

ISSP is Vietnam's first and only international school for Early Years and Elementary children. Opened in 2011 and located in the Binh Thanh district of Ho Chi Minh City, ISSP welcomes both local and international families with over 30 nationalities represented through the student body.

Over the past two years, ISSP has experienced a considerable period of growth in all aspects of school life. From creating a dynamic leadership team, committing to an ambitious facility redevelopment plan by modernizing learning environments to meet the needs of learners to embedding a strong curriculum that engages and challenges students every day. In 2018, ISSP became fully accredited by the Council of International Schools and the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. Enrollment has grown by 60% since 2016 with 412 students forecasted for August 2021.

The students, and their families, are at the center of all that we do at ISSP. We take pride in building a strong community whilst supporting every child to reach their individual potential through a personalized experience.

OUR DIMENSIONS FOR LEARNING

International School Saigon Pearl's model for learning is the ISSP Dimensions. This comprises of four distinct but interwoven dimensions: Conceptually Framed; Inquiry Based; Student Agency; Skills. This forms our school's dominant pedagogy.

- Conceptually Framed and Inquiry: a transdisciplinary approach to develop an enduring understanding of the school-wide concepts. Units of Inquiry have been developed for each Grade Level, which is taught in conjunction with our ISSP Curriculum.
- Skills: Using the common core standards we teach skills using Lucy Calkins' Writer's Workshop Model. We explicitly teach phonics and guided reading on a daily basis. We use the NY Engage curriculum for mathematics.
- Student Agency: Student voice and choice in their learning.

REGGIO INSPIRED EARLY YEARS EDUCATION

International School Saigon Pearl's model for learning our Early Years Department is Reggio inspired with a pedagogy that promotes learning through play. This is our dominant pedagogy for our Early Years Program.

RESTORATIVE PRACTICE AND STUDENT SUPPORT



How we work with children and the relationships we establish can be the difference between success and failure, and how they see themselves as learners. ISSP applies Restorative Practices which focus on building relationships, creating obligations, opportunity for making things right, and builds character by having children learn to make good decisions by making decisions. Our approach develops long term change in a child's character.

Our Student Support team consists of a School Counselor, a team of English as an Additional Language teachers and Special Educational Needs Coordinator. In collaboration with all staff, our collective aim is to ensure all children develop their full potential through appropriate support, collaboration, commitment and communication among teachers, other related professionals, and parents. We promote the successful inclusion of all children whilst meeting their individual needs through a personalized approach to learning.

It is ISSP's belief that all children have the right to receive quality education by capitalizing on individual strengths. We recognize and respect individual differences and uniqueness and take responsibility in providing skilled and sensitive teaching and support so that children with different learning styles, abilities and skills can find individual paths to success and fulfillment.

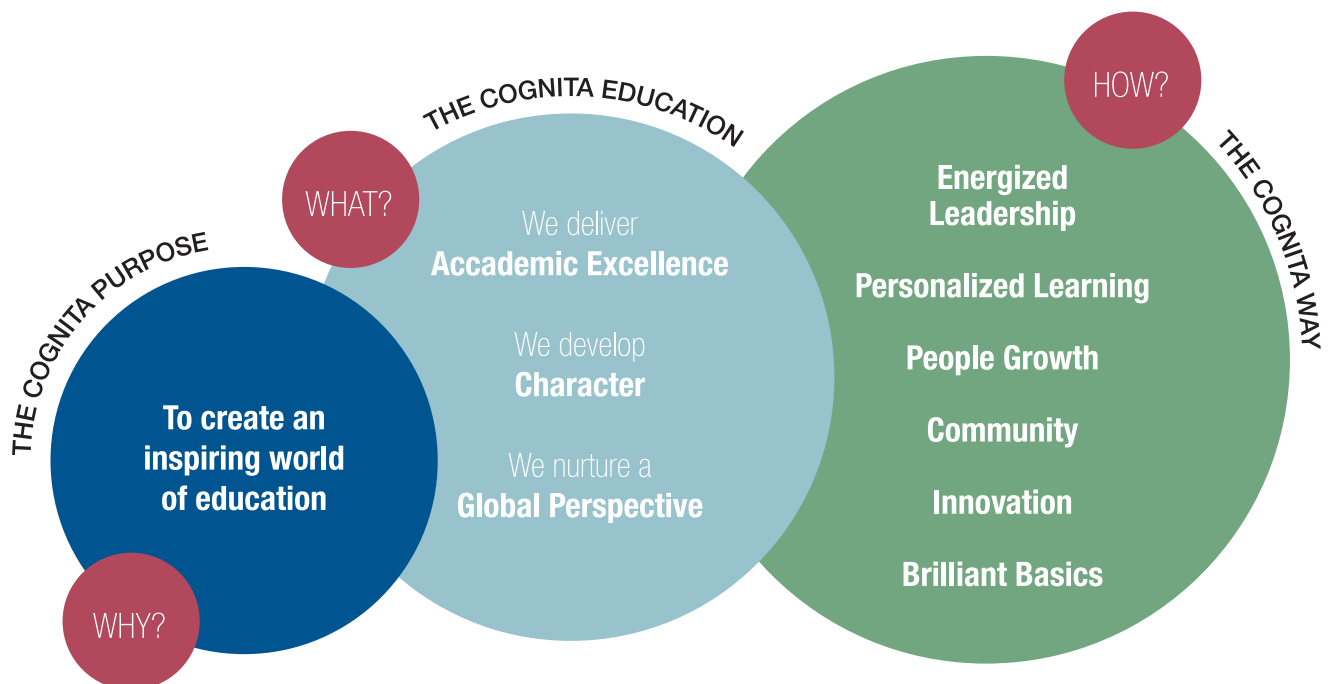

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

ISSP is a small and close-knit community, a great place to work, and a positive learning environment with supportive staff and a great leadership team. We offer a competitive salary and compensation package for successful candidates with the following notes:

We offer two types of contracts:

- 2 year contracts for overseas hired expatriates
- 1 year for locally hired expatriates

Starting salary point: approximately 40,000 USD gross per year.

Overseas Hired Expatriates Package includes: housing allowance, flight benefits, shipping benefits, health insurance, sick leave, personal leave, tuition waiver for up to 2 (two) children, professional development opportunities and a relocation/settling-in allowance.

Locally Hired Expatriates Package includes: health insurance, sick leave, personal leave, professional development opportunities. The annual home flight benefit is offered once signing a second contract. It is possible that the school could honor the benefits from your former local school.

SAFEGUARDING
